Synopsis Regular Board Meeting Minutes
February 8, 2005

Supervisor Little called the regular board meeting to order at 8:00 p.m. Supervisor Little, Treasurer Haeussler, Clerk Alexa, Trustees Horning and Weidmayer all present. Motion by Horning, seconded by Haeussler, to approve the January 11 2005, regular board minutes, motion carried by all ayes. Motion by Little seconded by Weidmayer to approve treasurers report. Motion passed unanimously by a roll call vote.

Reports:

Planning Commission had there annual review of the gravel pits, they are asking the pits to have there bonds all expiring on the same day January 31st every year. Gravel pit tour will be May 7th starting at 8:30am at C & T. The planner is reviewing the property that the county bought at Waters & Parker.

Ordinance Enforcement Bemis rd. resident received another letter regarding the extraction of materials that there will be no more digging until the board sees two years of receipts. A motion by Little seconded by Horning to purchase a decimal meter. Motion passed unanimously by a roll call vote.

Zoning Inspector no zoning in the month of January.

Clerk Report – Road commission will survey Pleasant Lake rd from Fletcher to Schneider road. Once the survey is completed, the township will get the results to see if the speed limit should be reduced. Motion by Horning seconded by Little for the clerk to sign all four school election contracts to conduct the elections for the schools for the next two years. Motion carried by all ayes.

Business:

Modern Wastes Systems was tabled until next month we are asking to see a contract. The administration fee on the tax bill was tabled until next month; board members are looking over the idea. The tree removal is complete at the intersection of Bethel Church and Steinbach. Rena Girbach a previous Freedom township clerk will be honored at the Washtenaw County Fair grounds for all her volunteering in the community. Township salary increases were approved for the clerk and the supervisor motion by Weidmayer seconded by Horning, a roll call vote resulted in 2 ayes and one abstain. February 24th at 7:30 will be the history meeting at the town hall, anyone interested may attend. The Freedom township webpage has been turned over to the township by the county for updating, due to Freedom township residents going through training. The county has a new program wireless Washtenaw they are trying to provide high-speed internet to the rural areas. Motion by Little seconded by Weidmayer to approve the warrants. Motion passed unanimously by a roll call vote. The meeting was adjourned at 9:21 p.m.
