Synopsis Board Meeting Minutes
August 2, 2006

Supervisor Little called the regular board meeting to order at 8:00 p.m. Board members Little, Alexa, Haeussler, Horning and Weidmayer were present. July 11, 2006 regular board minutes, and treasurer's report were approved.

Audience Participation: Resident was not aware about Michigan Paving Aggregates, that they have a condition use permit for a 49-acre lake.

Planning Commission: Washtenaw county parks tabled. August 10th at 7pm there will be a working session for amendments for the Extradition ordinance. Barrett Lake updates, there was a letter from MDEQ asking for clarification on time lines. Property on Scio Church rd, is teaching about herbs, PC is looking to see if they need a conditional use permit. Michigan Paving Aggregates gave an update on the gravel pit; they are estimating 2014 they will begin to dig. The planner is looking at a private wastewater ordinance for Freedom Township; it would mostly effect new development.

Zoning Inspector: Two zoning permits one for an address and one for a tool shed.

Clerk's report: Audit has been completed. Election is next Tuesday with the new auto mark machine. Read an article on SOS that is being proposed for the ballot in November.

Business: Mark Roby made a presentation on LIAA grant, there are two major items, one is to promote growth around the Village of Manchester and the other is to reduce pressure on the rural and agricultural lands, there was a motion to support the LIAA grant with \$1000, motion passed unanimously. Terry Brinkman from Washtenaw county gave a presentation on PDR, the township has four options two to enter in to an PDR agreement with the county, one to not enter and the other to do nothing, more discussion will take place on PDR. The township board asks the Planning commission to look at land division fees. The board chooses not to provide financial assistants to the Enbridge appeals case. Warrants were approved. The meeting was adjourned at 10:22 p.m.
